Growth in manufacturing jobs support broader job growth as well and there was over 250,000 new job created last month and with historically low unemployment we also have growth in real wages at the highest level since 1969. That's a compelling story and it is certainly linked to the story of our Growth Capital 2018 IMPACT Award Winner, Tymex Plastics.

Tymex Plastics is part of that strong growth in manufacturing right here in Cleveland, having increased overall production by 62%, topline revenues by 41% and an increase in its workforce of more than 34% since working with Growth Capital. That's real IMPACT. More manufacturing producing real goods, creating more wealth and providing more employment opportunities for the people in our communities. Employment that brings rising wages that support real people, real families and has a real IMPACT. 


2018 Loan Activity

Growth Capital certainly continued creating real value for small business with its loan activity. This year, we had 73 loans approvals and maintained the Number One SBA 504 and Community Advantage Lender status in Northeast Ohio. While SBA 504 lending in the district increased last year, we were able to hold our own and maintain our market share at 44% in the SBA Cleveland District with total project financing of \$58.2MM.

Growth Capital had a good year with \$26 million in approved loans which leveraged over \$84.7 million in economic development investment in our communities during 2018. Our participation has adding significantly to the overall economic activity of our region with the potential to add over 400 new jobs for Ohio workers. Loan closing production for fiscal year 2018 totaled 50 loans funded through September 30, 2018 with loan closing dollar volume reaching \$28.8MM.

When three hardworking entrepreneurs, with very diverse backgrounds came together in 2001, nobody could have anticipated what has come to be. Nearly 18 years later, Tymex Plastics has become an industry leader in custom compounding and recycling for the rotational molding industry. Tymex Plastics, Inc. was founded by Michael Turkovich, President, Eric Yarabenetz, Director of Sales; and Mark Simonitis, Vice President and still operates from industrial space on Harvard Avenue right off of Interstate 77. Over these last 18 years Tymex has seen a considerable sales growth and a threefold employee growth. It was named a Weatherhead Top 100 fifth place award in 2006.

Tymex Plastics will process nearly 57 million pounds of plastics in 2018, a 62% increase from 2014. This growth was achieved thru the drive to continually recognize opportunities for improvement within the company. That vision and that desire has earned Tymex a reputation of quality, consistency and dependability in its industry.

Owner Michael Turkovich stated, "If our 18-year history has taught us anything, it's that relationships are vitally important. We have worked very hard to form strong relationships with customers, vendors, and financial partners. None more apparent than the relationships we have formed with Growth Capital, Chase Bank and John Barth".

Growth Capital approved it's first of five SBA 504 loans for the company in 2014, providing financing to fund the purchase of capital equipment that continues to fuel company growth and Tymex knows what it takes to succeed with Mark Simonitis saying. "We appreciate the confidence and support that we have received from Growth Capital and Chase Bank. They are strong institutions, and we are glad to be working with them. But we also realize that companies are only as strong as the people that represent them. John Barth is a testament to that. John's hard work with both companies on our behalf, was instrumental in obtaining the financing Tymex needed to allow for our company's growth and stability. He understands it's about more than just numbers, it's also about people and relationships. John spent time to learn about our company and who we are as people. He saw our vision and our passion and funneled that information thru the proper channels".

During Fiscal Year 2018, there were 25 loan prepayments, amounting to \$4,643,721.15, a 47% decrease over the previous year. The new loan activity over prepayments caused the portfolio to increase by \$14,818,022.57 or 12.8%.

Growth Capital managed 4 (all SBA 504) loans in liquidation during fiscal year 2018. There were 0 charge-offs of loans in liquidation.

As of Fiscal 2018 year-end, Growth Capital has no loans in the process of being liquidated.

As of 09/30/2018 Growth Capital had a delinquency rate of 1.06% compared to an SBA bench rate of .60% and a peer group rate of .69%. For the fiscal 2018 year, The SBA Lender Risk Rating has remained at 2.
